He was baptized at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond and confirmed at the Zion Lutheran Church in Plainview. He attended Immanuel Lutheran Country School and Zion Lutheran School, and then graduated from Plainview High School in 1951. Donald grew up in the Osmond area. He served in the United States Army from 1954-1956 at Fort Lewis, Washington. He married Elsa Arendt on August 25, 1956 in Tacoma, WA. After marriage, Don and Elsa farmed in the Osmond area. Don also did housing construction in the Yankton area along the Missouri River. The family moved to Osmond in 1985 and Don worked at worked the Osmond Farm

Supply for 11 years. Don was a coach for the Osmond American Legion and youth baseball teams in Osmond throughout the years. He played men's fast pitch softball for Osmond. He enjoyed playing cards, crossword puzzles, golfing, dancing, singing and playing the accordion with family members and siblings. He was a member of the American Legion in Osmond, Nebraska and Toastmasters Club.

Survivors include his spouse Elsa Gloe of Osmond, children Diana Behlers of Norfolk, Anita Gloe of Bakersfield, CA, Edith Gloe of Santa Clarita, CA, Lorenz Gloe of Omaha, Rachel (Mark) Pacha of Omaha, 7 grandchildren, 5 great-grandchildren, brother Oran (Lois) Gloe of Plainview, Darryl Gloe of Mesa, AZ. 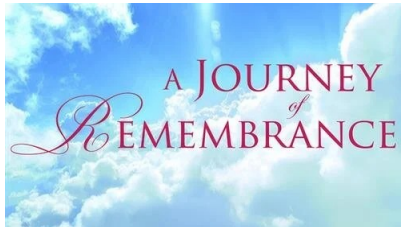

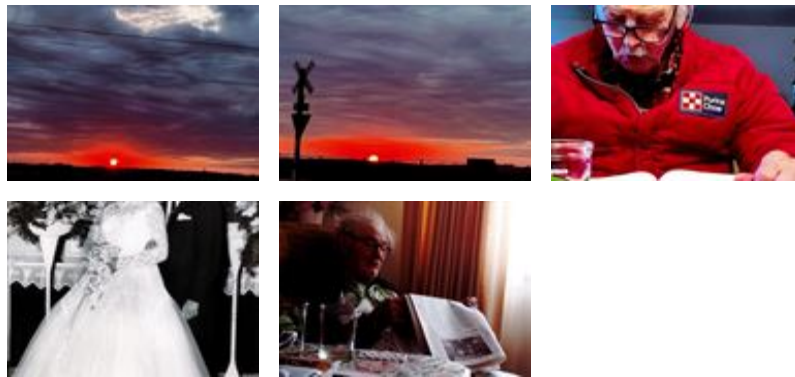
