Donna June Brown was born June 2, 1930, in Madison, the daughter of Henry and Agnes (Buettner) Platt. She graduated from Madison High School in 1948.

Donna then worked in the cafeteria at the Nebraska Veterans Home until she retired in 1992.

She enjoyed playing cards, feeding her cats, gardening, canning, seamstress work, and she especially loved watching her grandchildren. She was a member of Mount Olive Lutheran Church and its ladies aid, the Lutheran Women's Missionary League and the American Legion Auxiliary.

and lived there until her death.
