They were divorced. She worked at Becton Dickinson in Columbus. She then worked at Dale Electronics in Columbus and Norfolk. Then Donna set up self-sufficiency homes for the state of Northeast Nebraska housing. She later retired. She enjoyed her granddaughters, family, gardening, sewing, playing cards and baking. She was a member of Zion Lutheran Church, Pierce. Survivors include three children, Doug and wife Jean Lewis of Plainview, Barbara and husband Steven Buettgenbach of Pierce and Sheryl Lewis of Pierce; four granddaughters, five stepgrandchildren and six stepgreat-grandchildren; one brother, Robert and wife Glenda Zierke of Pierce; and one sister, Patricia and husband Dale Koehler of Pierce.
