Doris was a homemaker while raising their daughters. Doris was active in the Parent Teacher Association and Girl Scouts. She also worked from home as a seamstress until 1971, when she began working at J.C. Penny in the alteration department for several years. She also enjoyed gardening, tending

to her beautiful flowers, baking, and music. In later years, she enjoyed jigsaw puzzles while listening to music.

Doris is survived by her daughters, Sherry Carson of Ashaway, RI, Brenda (Dave) Hendren of Norfolk, Marilyn (Leonard) Mach of Norfolk, 11 grandchildren, and 22 great-grandchildren.
