



## Dorothy M. Korn

July 22, 1920 - October 23, 2017

NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Dorothy M. Korn, 97, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Friday, October 27, 2017 at the Trinity Lutheran Church in Hoskins with Rev. Rodney Rixe officiating. Interment will be at the Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery, Norfolk. Visitation will begin at 10:00 a.m., Friday prior to the Funeral service also at the church. Dorothy died Monday, October 23, 2017 at the Premier Estates in Pierce.

Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Dorothy Mae Korn was born July 22, 1920 at Norfolk, Nebraska, the daughter of Alfred and Emma (Tiedtke) Korn. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran Faith and was lifelong resident of Norfolk. She graduated from Norfolk High School in 1938 and from Norfolk Junior College in 1944 and also attended Concordia Teachers College in Seward, Nebraska. Following graduation from High School, she was employed at the Norfolk Public Library. She was on the Norfolk High School faculty as Librarian from 1944-1949.

During the summer she worked part time at the Norfolk Theatres, later becoming assistant Manager. She retired in 1982 as City Manager for Central States Theatre Corporation, Des Moines, Iowa managing the Granada, Cinema III and Norfolk Drive Inn Theatre in Norfolk. She was employed by the Granada Productions part time for 14 years after retiring. Miss Korn was named on the Hall of Success for the Norfolk Junior College in 1970, and was the first female manager to receive Manager of the year from Central States Theatre Corporation, receiving the award in 1973. She was also runner-up for

Manager of the Year for Drive Inn Theatres in 1972. Among her activities in the Lutheran Church were 20 years as a Vacation Bible School teacher, and she also taught Sunday school for many years. She was active in the Ladies Aid and the Lutheran Women's Missionary Society, holding offices in both groups, including President. Miss Korn was an Associate Member of The National Ninth Air Force Association. She was preceded in death by her parents Alfred and Emma, three sisters, Flora Rowland, Louise Wehrer and Margaret Sommerfeld, a brother Alfred Allen Korn. She is survived by several nieces and nephews, and other relatives and friends. Organist is Jeannie Marotz. Casket bearers for the service will be Larry Voecks, Myron Tiedtke, Michael Unger, Roger Ellenberger. Honorary casket bearers will be Kent McCallum, Dr. Monte Middleton, Michael Brtek.

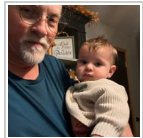

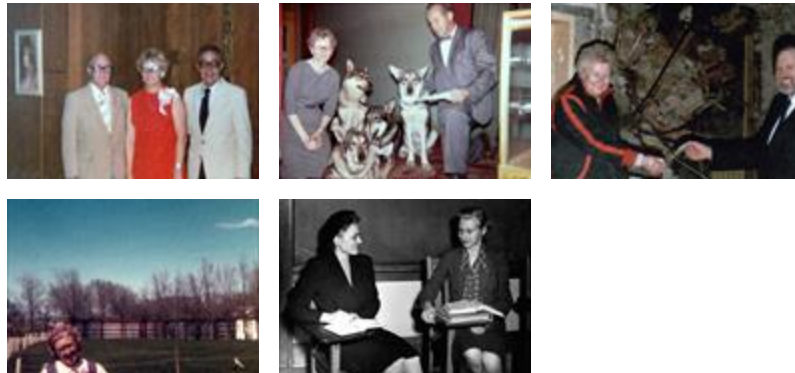
