



Douglas Gene Nuttelmann

January 27, 1933 - May 29, 2022

NORFOLK – Private memorial service for Douglas Gene Nuttelmann, 89, of Norfolk will be officiated by Pastor Peter H. Jark-Swain at the Trinity Episcopal Church in Norfolk. Inurnment will be held at the Trinity Episcopal Church Columbarium. Military rites will be provided by the American Legion Post 16, V.F.W. Post 1644, both of Norfolk and the United States Navy Honors Guard. He passed away on Saturday, May 29, 2022 at the Faith Regional Hospital in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Douglas was born on January 27, 1933 in Norfolk, NE to Mahlon and Suzanna (Walmsley) Nuttelmann Sr. As a child, Douglas was an altar boy at the Episcopal Church. He joined the United States Navy serving four years from December 4, 1951 to November 30, 1955 and he fought in the Korean War as a gunner aboard the U.S.S. Epping Forest LSD-4, receiving the purple heart. After serving in the Navy, he worked 39 years for the City of Norfolk.

In 1975 Douglas was appointed as the water and sewer director of the city of Norfolk until he retired in 1994. In 1952, Douglas married Gay Tannehill and they had four children. In 1959, he married Angeline “Bonnie” Earwood and had one child.

He is survived by his spouse Bonne Nuttelmann of Norfolk, children Michael (Sally) Nuttelmann of Norfolk, Twyla (Jim) Marr of Norfolk, Mitch Nuttelmann

of Madison, SD, Mark (Lori) Nuttelmann of Norfolk, Jeffrey J. Nuttelmann of Norfolk, 13 grandchildren, and 12 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents Mahlon Sr. and Suzanna, 2 grandchildren, brother Mahlon "Rudy."
