WAUSA — Services for Dwyla M. Whaley, 84, Norfolk, will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at the Wausa City Auditorium in Wausa. Stanley Morrison will officiate with burial in the Magnet City Cemetery. Visitation will be 4-7 p.m. Friday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk.

Dwyla Whaley, 84, passed away Friday, July 15, 2016, at the Golden Living Center in Norfolk with her family by her side, following a brief illness.

Dwyla May Bartlett was born Aug. 20, 1931, at Magnet, to Albert Bartlett and Viola (Black) Bartlett. She attended rural school near her home and Magnet Public School. In 1944, at age 13, she made her choice to serve Jesus and that was her priority all of her days. After her schooling, she worked a short time at Sacred Heart Hospital in Yankton.

On Jan. 15, 1952, she married Fred Whaley of Callaway. To this union were born four children: Cheryl (Rodger) Anderson of Princeton, Minn., Kurt Whaley (Vicky Nickel) of Sioux Falls, S.D., Kyle Fred Whaley (deceased in 1973 at age 11), and Kimberly Whaley of Greeley, Colo. Dwyla and her spouse raised their family in the Magnet area. In 1993, they moved to Norfolk, where they lived until her passing.

She is survived by her spouse, Fred; her three children; a sister, Karolyn Kleeb of O'Neill; a sister-in-law, Lois Bartlett of Des Moines, Iowa; 10 grandchildren: Nathan Whaley, Rachel Guevara, Rebecca Whaley, Jess Whaley, Bill Anderson, Bjorn Anderson, Katie Anderson, Tammy Palm, Nick Randall and Kerri Randall; nine great-grandchildren: Lily Whaley, Morgan
