RANDOLPH – Funeral service for Earl B. Leiting, 75, of Randolph will be held at 10:30 a.m., Monday, January 22, 2024 at St. Jane Frances Catholic Church in Randolph. Interment will take place at St. Frances Catholic Cemetery, rural Randolph. Visitation will be held from 3:00-5:00 p.m., Sunday with rosary starting at 5:00 p.m., also at St. Jane Frances Catholic Church in Randolph. Military rites will be conducted by the V.F.W. Alvin Kessler Post #5545, American Legion Post #113, and the United States Army Honors Guard. In lieu of flowers the family asks that donations be made to the Lied Randolph Public Library or St. Jane Frances Catholic Church. Earl died on Sunday, January 14, 2024 at his residence rural Randolph with family by his side. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Earl was born on May 13, 1948 in Osmond, NE to Vernice and Velna (Gubbels) Leiting. Earl grew up on the family farm near Randolph. He attended grade school in Randolph and graduated from St. Frances High School in Randolph in 1966.
