Eileen passed away on Tuesday, March 17, 2026 at the Providence Medical Center in Wayne. Stonacek Memorial Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Eileen Frieda Esther Schulz was born on August 30th, 1937 on the family farm east of Pierce, as the third in a line of six girls to George and Grace (Buckendahl) Schulz. While on the farm her duties included making sure that her grandma Ernestine Schulz made it back from her walks when she would wander off, also taking care of her youngest sister JoAnn. Her older sisters Leoma and Lois got to do most of the outside chores and ride the horses while Eileen took care of the chickens and helped with the cooking. Later they moved to town where sisters Donna and Jerilyn were born.

Eileen was baptized at St. John's Lutheran Church and attended St. John's Lutheran School where she was also confirmed. She graduated from Pierce High School in 1955. After graduation she went to work in the Pierce County

Courthouse Welfare Office.

She married Rudolph J. Zierke on January 4th, 1959. To this union they were blessed with 3 daughters Kathryn, Rhonda, and Sandra. They resided in Norfolk, then moved to Pierce upon purchasing and operating Rudy's IGA grocery store. During this time she also took care of her mother Grace. After closing the store she began working as the secretary at Zion Lutheran Church, bartender on Thursday nights for Pierce Lanes and later at the Legion Lounge. She enjoyed her "friends of the round table" after a long day.

Music was a big part of her life. She played trumpet in the Pierce High School Band. She loved to sing with her sisters at family gatherings. She loved to dance with husband Rudy and sing with him in the choir at church and around the campfire at their cabin on the Missouri River near Yankton. She organized and led the Pierce High Alumni Pep Band for many years. Receiving the 2010 "Outstanding Pierce Alumni Community Award". Eileen had many fond memories with her children, grandchildren and great grandchildren, whether it be watching sports, playing games, or joking around. They loved staying at her house and all the surprises of food, laughter, and lectures.

She was an active member of Trinity Lutheran Church and the American Legion Auxiliary where she held the office as President for many years.

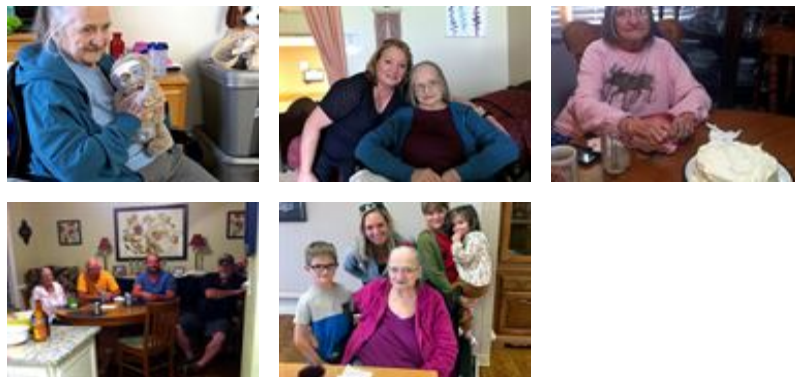
