Elaine B. Nitz of Norfolk was born Oct. 2, 1932, in Norfolk, the daughter of Ernest A. and Minnie D. (Klug) Hille. She was baptized at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Norfolk and confirmed at Christ Lutheran Church in Norfolk on April 16, 1946. She attended Norfolk Public Schools and Christ Lutheran School and graduated from Norfolk High School in 1950. After high school, Elaine worked for Dr. A.P. Herbst dental office.

After her marriage to Arvin Nitz on June 2, 1952, at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Norfolk, they moved to Hastings. The family moved back and farmed in Pierce County until 1965, when they moved to Norfolk. Elaine worked at Wells Dental lab for 14 years. They owned and operated the Diet Center in Norfolk a short time. Elaine then worked for Walmart for 13 years until she retired.

Elaine enjoyed being around her children and grandchildren. She always had M&Ms to hand out.

She was a member of Christ Lutheran Church of Norfolk, Braille Group, Echo Group and was a past Sunday school teacher.

Survivors include her daughter, Diane Salazar of Norfolk; her sons, Ron (Cindy) Nitz of Norfolk, Dave (Diane) Nitz of Lincoln, Brian Nitz of Norfolk and Rick (Susan) Nitz of Norfolk; nine grandchildren; 13 great-grandchildren; many nieces and nephews; and a brother-in-law, Gerold Lichtenberg of Norfolk.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Ernest and Minnie; two brothers, Melvin and Willard; three sisters, Maxine, Loretta and Silvia; two brothers-in-law, Willard Stuckwisch and Lester Drefke; and two sisters-in-law, Lucille Hille and Dorothy Hille.
