Elsie passed away Saturday, February 18, 2017 at the Heritage of Bel-Air Nursing Home in Norfolk.

Elsie V. (Hilkemann) Lockwood, daughter of the Rev. David and Ethel (James) Simpson, was born May 30, 1916, in Cereal Alberta, Canada. She graduated from Randolph High School in 1934.

Elsie taught at a rural country school in the Randolph area before marrying Herbert Hilkemann on May 30, 1938, in Shelton. Herbert and Elsie farmed in the Sholes area. After Herbert passed away in November 1965, Elsie moved to Lincoln and went to nursing school to be a licensed practical nurse. She worked as an LPN for 12 years at the Lutheran Hospital in Norfolk. She then moved to Escondido, Calif., where she continued working as an LPN.

She met Richard Lockwood in California, and they were married in May 1974 in Yuma, Ariz. They moved back to Nebraska in 1978 and lived in Stanton,

Neb. Richard passed away in November 1980. She later then moved to Norfolk in 1982.

Elsie loved to play the piano; she played the piano while she lived at the Meadows in Norfolk until she was 96. She also enjoyed playing cards, sewing and crossword puzzles.

She was a member of First Christian Church in Norfolk and a past member at the United Methodist Church. She helped out at Norfolk Senior Center and also helped out at Thursday men's breakfast.

Survivors are her sons, Ron (Donna) Hilkemann of Norfolk, Sen. Robert (Julie) Hilkemann of Omaha; daughter-in-law Bonnie Hilkemann of Geneva, Ill.; eight grandchildren; and 19 great-grandchildren; a sister, Doris Ring of Ponca City, Okla.

She was preceded in death by both spouses, Herbert Hilkemann and Richard Lockwood; a son, the Rev. Larry Hilkemann; her parents, the Rev. David and Ethel Simpson; and sisters Lillian Saunders, Pat Gilman and Kathleen Simpson.

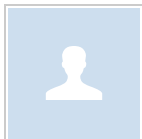

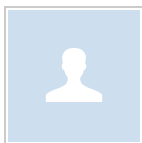

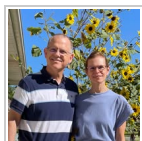
