



## Elton L. Weich

February 2, 1932 - July 1, 2015

NORFOLK -- Services for Elton L. Weich, 83, of rural Hoskins will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday at St. John's Lutheran Church in Pierce. The Rev. John E. Nelson will officiate with burial in Zion Lutheran East Cemetery in rural Hoskins. Military rites will be conducted by American Legion Tomek-Otto Post 72 of Pierce and U.S. Army Honors Guard.

Visitation will be 5-8 p.m. Sunday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk.

He died Wednesday, July 1, 2015, at the Norfolk Veterans Home.

The son of Venus and Alice (Donner) Weich was born Feb. 4, 1932, on the family farm at rural Hoskins. He was baptized and confirmed at the former Zion Lutheran East Church rural Hoskins. He attended School District 77 to the eighth grade in Wayne County.

On Sept. 5, 1954, he married Bonnie Spence at the First United Methodist Church in Norfolk. He served in the U.S. Army from Oct. 5, 1955, to July 5, 1957. Elton farmed with his father throughout his life on the Hoskins farm where he was born. After retiring, he began a pocket gopher control business. He loved the farm, music, family, friends and telling jokes. He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Pierce.

Survivors are his wife, Bonnie Weich of Norfolk; two daughters, Tammy and husband Darrell Matson of Omaha and Lisa and husband Dale Samuelson of Norfolk; four grandchildren, Laura and Christopher Samuelson and Garrett and Andrew Matson; and a sister, Inez Freeman of Pierce.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Venus and Alice, and a sister,

Delma Vyhlidal.
