HADAR -- Services for Ewald M. Gehm, 91, of Pierce will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday at Immanuel Lutheran Church at Hadar with burial in Prospect View Cemetery at Pierce and military rites by American Legion Post 72 and the United States Army Honors Guard. Visitation will be 3-8 p.m. Sunday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. The Rev. Nathaniel Winkel will officiate. He died Wednesday, Aug. 15, 2012, at Heritage of Bel-Air in Norfolk. He was born Oct. 13, 1920, in rural Pierce County to Herman and Henny (Bunjes) Gehm. He was baptized at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Hadar, on Oct. 21, 1920, and confirmed there May 26, 1935, with confirmation verse Revelations 12, verse 11. He attended parochial school in Hadar at Immanuel Lutheran School through the eighth grade. He married Betty Weinrich at Zion Lutheran Church, Pierce, on June 6, 1946. The couple farmed south of Pierce. He continued to live at his farm home until April of 2012 when he moved to assisted living in Norfolk at The Meadows and later moved to Heritage of Bel-Air in Norfolk. He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Hadar. He served in World War II in the Army and received the Bronze Star and four battle stars. He was inducted Feb. 18, 1943, and discharged Dec. 8, 1945. Survivors include daughter Connie and husband Daniel Abegglen of Columbus; one son, Craig and wife Carol (Jeanie) Gehm of Norfolk; five grandchildren and four great- grandchildren and special friend Darlene Froehlich of Pierce. He was preceded in death by his parents, wife Betty Gehm on March 1, 1996, one grandchild Sharon, two sisters and one sister in
