NORFOLK – Memorial service for Gary Gale Rabbass, 81, of Norfolk, will be held at 1:00 p.m., Friday, April 3, 2026 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. 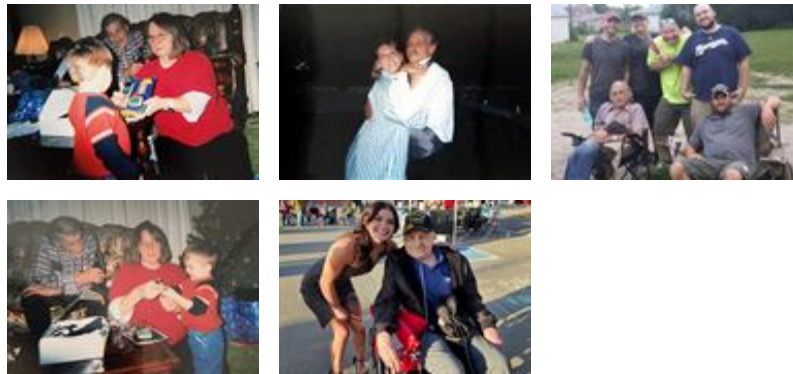

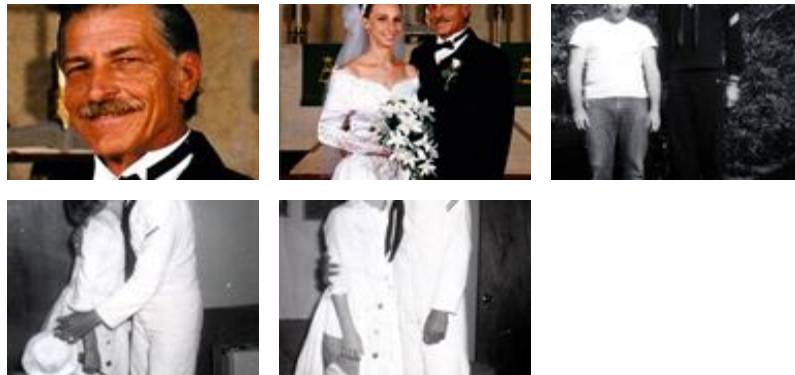
