Gary passed away on Sunday, February 18, 2024 at the University of Nebraska-Medical Center in Omaha. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Gary was born on February 3, 1955 in Norfolk, Nebraska to Kenneth and Marlene (Eymann) Smith. He attended Norfolk Catholic School through the 9th grade (1970), then attended Norfolk Public 10th-12th grade, graduated in 1973. He then attended Northeast Community College in the mid 70's for the electrician program and later went back for electronics /computers at Northeast Community College in 1988. Gary married Christine "Chris" Suber on September 19, 1981 at the St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Wayne.

Gary lived in Norfolk his whole life. He worked at Good Year Tires, self-employed electrician for a while, Geary Electric, Marathon Press, and has

been working at Faith Regional Health and Human Services for 27 years, planning on retiring in May, 2024. He loved visiting Kyle and Mikayla. Gary enjoyed swimming, riding his bike, and being active with anything. He had big plans to Kayak the Missouri River. Gary loved Nebraska Cornhusker football and volleyball, Kansas City Chiefs football, spending time at the Timperley's ranch for concerts, and his kids pets especially his "Bella Babes." Gary Fully believed cars weren't meant to go over 55 and oil needs to be changed every 3000 miles. He loved his yard-mom said for anyone wondering he has the instructions for the yard hanging on the fridge.

Gary is survived by his spouse Chris Smith of Norfolk, children Kyle (Becky) Smith of Memphis, TN, Mikayla Smith (significant other Mike Tarrant) of Kansas City, siblings Francis (Linda) Smith of St. Joseph, MO, Kenneth Jr. (Brenda) Smith of Norfolk, Robert "Bob" (Carolyn) Smith of Plainview, and Debbie (Larry) Stockman of Sioux City, IA. 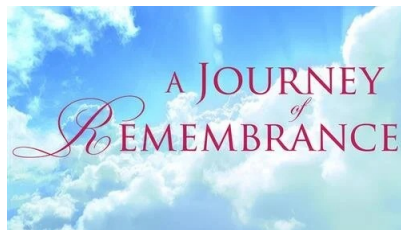
