George Stephen Dufalla was born, June 28, 1940 in Niles, Ohio to parents Stephen and Eva Dufalla. He grew up in Niles. He graduated from McKinley High School in Canton, Ohio in 1958. George joined the service of the Marine Corp and served his country honorably. His bravery during the Vietnam War earned him a certificate of achievement. He continued in a role of service as a police officer in Los Angeles until 1978 when an injury forced an early retirement. In 1974 he married his wife of 44 years, Barbara J. Fox. George remained a classic car enthusiast, a lover of the outdoors, and a lifelong, devoted servant of Christ.

George is preceded in death by his father Stephen, mother Eva, and brother John. He is survived by wife, Barbara Dufalla of Norfolk, Nebraska, daughters, Dina Dufalla of Norfolk, Nebraska, and Stacy (Brian) Martinez of White Bear Township, Minnesota, grandsons, Jacob and Elijah Martinez of White Bear
