



Gerald T. "Jerry" Pint

PIERCE -- Funeral service for Gerald T. Pint, 84, of Pierce will be held at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, July 5, 2017 at the St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Pierce with Father Marc Lim officiating. Gerald died Saturday, July 1, 2017 at the Faith Regional Hospital in Norfolk. Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce is in charge of the arrangements.

Gerald Pint was born June 23, 1933 to Theodore and Theresa (Pfeifer) Pint on a farm West of Pierce. He attended St. Joseph's Catholic school and graduated from Pierce High School in 1950.

After graduating, Gerald helped his father farm until his service in the United States Army from 1953 to 1955 in the 503rd Engineers, where he utilized his knowledge of machinery as a crane operator to help rebuild bridges in Germany.

On June 12, 1956, Gerald married Lavine Gubbels at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Osmond. The couple farmed West of Pierce.

Gerald was a member of the St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Catholic Order of Foresters, Knights of Columbus, 3rd Degree, and past Grand Knight, Holy Name Society, and the Pierce American Legion.

Gerald and Lavine enjoyed traveling, which included trips to Ireland, Germany, Medjugorje, England, Italy, and Canada.

In his free time, he enjoyed basketball, baseball, fixing fence, and sawing wood. He also enjoyed attending his grandchildren's soccer, football, and track events.
