He died Sunday, March 29, 2015, at Community Pride Care Center in Battle Creek after a long battle with Lewy Body disease.

The son of John and Edith (Braasch) Rossmeier was born May 16, 1936, in Pierce County. He was baptized and confirmed at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar. He attended Pierce High School.

He married Geraldine Dinkel on Feb. 16, 1958, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar. After marriage, Gerald farmed south of Pierce. He also did work for Clipston Service in Hadar until 1987, hauling fuel until his retirement. In 1988, Gerald and Geraldine moved to Norfolk.

Gerald enjoyed hunting, fishing and flying. He had a love for his dogs and spending time with his family. He was a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Norfolk. Earlier in life, Gerald was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Hadar. He served on various boards in Hadar.
