Herbolsheimer was born May 3, 1928, in Norfolk, the daughter of Raymond and Marie (Kohl) Groninger. She was baptized at the Methodist church and confirmed in the Lutheran faith at St. John's Lutheran Church in Pierce on Dec. 4, 1949. She graduated from Battle Creek High School in 1945. She married Myron Herbolsheimer on Oct. 12, 1947, at St. John's Parsonage in rural Pierce. After Geraldine and Myron were married, they farmed east of Pierce for three years. They then moved into Pierce, where she later on worked at National Foods. Geraldine later on worked in the office for Dale Electronics in Norfolk. She then did child care from her home. She moved to Norfolk in 1988. Geraldine enjoyed reading, puzzles and spending time with her family. She did volunteer work at Lutheran Hospital in Norfolk and was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in rural Pierce. Survivors include two daughters, Sherry (Doug) Grimm of West Point and Gale (David) Rossmeier of Sheridan, Wyo.; two sons, Glen (Kay) Herbolsheimer of Norfolk and Jon Herbolsheimer of Norfolk; eight grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; a brother, Don (Kathy) Groninger of Omaha; one sister, Ellen (Loren) Newman of Los Angeles, Calif.; and a sister-

in-law, Carol Groninger of Denver, Colo. She was preceded in death by her parents, Raymond and Marie; spouse Myron, who died in May 1981; two brothers, Norman and Elwyn; and two sisters, Iva Brummond and Beth Honsgermeier.
