RANDOLPH — Memorial services for Geraldine (Gerry) Rudebusch, 92, Livingston, Texas, formerly of Randolph, were at the Escapee's Care Center in Livingston. The Rev. Ray Gearing officiated. Burial will be at Rose Hill Cemetery near McLean.

Geraldine (Gerry) Koehn Rudebusch passed away peacefully on Sunday, Jan. 10, 2016. For the past two and half years, she was residing, under loving support, at Provident Memory Care.

Geraldine was born on her parents' farm, located in Pierce County, on Jan. 1, 1924. She was the only daughter of Arthur and Dorothy Henzler Koehn. She had one loving brother, Lowell Koehn. She attended rural one-room schools, parochial school and graduated from Pierce High School, later attending Wayne State College. Geraldine taught in one room country schools for 10 years and Sunday school for 22 years.

Geraldine married the love of her life, Vernon Rudebusch, on Dec. 26, 1947, at Christ Lutheran Church by the Rev. Harms in Norfolk. They were blessed with 68 years of marriage; to this union three sons were born. Most of their married life was spent on a farm in Nebraska. She loved being a farmer's wife and helping with all the daily chores. She also enjoyed reading, doing crossword puzzles and polka music. Vernon and Geraldine enjoyed being winter Texans during their later years.

Geraldine was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church, Church Circles and her neighborhood Sew & So Club, all in Randolph.

Geraldine is survived by her spouse, Vernon; and two sons, Daniel (Karla) of Livingston and John (Diane) of Randolph; seven grandchildren, David (Jacki) of Lincoln, Nicholas (Jenna) of Bay Town, Texas, Beth of Dallas, Texas, Jacob of Livingston, Joseph of Randolph, Hannah (Robert La France) of Houston, Texas, and Michael (Danielle) of Livingston; and four great-granddaughters, Briley Frye, Vivian, Ella and Cameron Rudebusch.
