



## Gertrude "Leona" Bargstadt

March 18, 1930 - June 12, 2025

NORFOLK – Celebration of life service for Gertrude “Leona” Bargstadt, 95 of Norfolk, will be held on Friday, June 20, 2025 at 10:30 a.m. at St. John’s Lutheran Church in Norfolk. Visitation will be held one hour prior to the services. Leona passed away on Thursday, June 12, 2025 at the Emerald Nursing Home in Columbus, NE. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements. In lieu of flowers, the family ask that donations be made out to St. Jude’s Children Research Hospital.

Leona Bargstadt was born on March 18, 1930 to Otis and Maybelle (Waltz) Auker in Auburn, Nebraska. She was received into the Kingdom of Grace through the Sacrament of Holy Baptism and Adult Confirmation June 4, 1946 at St. Paul’s Lutheran Church in Auburn. She attended rural schools and graduated from Auburn High School in 1947 and then attended Norfolk School of Beauty, Norfolk, NE.

She was united in marriage to Lester C. Bargstadt on November 7, 1948. This union was blessed with five children. They lived in Pierce until 1976, moving to Norfolk after retirement from the Motel 6 Inc in 1992. Leona was a member of Christ Lutheran Church in Pierce, NE where she belonged to the E.L.C.W. until moving to Norfolk where she joined St. John’s Lutheran Church. She was

a member of the church's quilt group.

She departed this life at 95 years and 3 months old.

She is preceded in death by her husband Lester C. Bargstadt, parents, 4 sisters, and 2 brothers.
