PIERCE — Gilbert G. Frahm, 87, of Pierce died Thursday, March 27, 2014, at the Norfolk Veterans Home. Private family services will be at a later date with burial in the Bloomfield City Cemetery. Arrangements are by Stonacek Memorial Chapel at Pierce. He was born Aug. 8, 1926, at rural Bloomfield to Hans and Clara (Nabor) Frahm. He attended Bloomfield High School, graduating in 1944. He served for two years in the Navy during World War II on the USS Zellars, from May 27, 1944, to May 21, 1946, as 3rd class petty officer-radar man. He married Leota (Dolly) Wheeler June 1, 1947, at Lindy. After marriage they farmed at Bloomfield and then owned and operated Bloomfield Lockers for several years. They later moved to Pierce, and he worked at Roman's for 15 years, retiring in 1989. Gilbert enjoyed golfing, hunting, fishing and playing cards. He was a member of the VFW, Norfolk, and Masonic Lodge. Survivors are children Alan and wife Linda Frahm of Ponca, Sue and husband Dave Brodhagen of Pierce and Bryan and wife Robin Frahm of Lyons; two grandchildren and three great-grandchildren; one brother, Calvin and wife Donna Frahm of Ponca; and one sister, Marcella Stark of Yankton. He was preceded in death by parents Hans and Clara, wife Dolly, daughter Diane and three grandchildren, Lucas, Sheila and Paul.
