PIERCE -- Gilbert H. Peters, 84, died Wednesday, May 9, 2012, at the Norfolk Veterans Home. He served in the Korean War with the U.S. Marines and was enlisted from Dec. 5, 1951, to Dec. 4, 1953, serving as a corporal. He married Ruth Ellis on July 28, 1953, at Las Vegas, Nev. They farmed in the Osmond and Pierce area. In August of 1998 they moved to Pierce. Gilbert enjoyed thinking of new inventions and gardening. He was a resident of the Pierce Manor in September of 2007 and the Norfolk Veterans Home in April of 2008. Lodge and church affiliations were the United Church of Christ Church, Pierce, and past church trustee and American Legion, Pierce, and past board member of the Pierce Co-Op.
