Gladys and Clarence farmed northeast of Pierce for 47 years. She raised chickens and attended to a large garden. They retired from farming and moved to the north edge of Pierce on an acreage. Years later, they moved into Pierce. Gladys enjoyed keeping busy, she worked at the Pierce Clothing store in Pierce, Pierce High School lunch cafeteria, and worked at the Pierce Senior Center. Gladys enjoyed spending time with her family, especially her grandchildren as much as they loved being with her. She had been at the Premier Estates since 2010. She also was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce.
