



## Gladys M. Weis

December 3, 1933 - December 31, 2015

NORFOLK -- Mass of Christian Burial for Gladys M. Weis, 79, will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Norfolk. Father Dan Andrews will officiate with the burial in Prospect Hill Cemetery. A rosary will be held at 3pm Sunday with visitation following until 7pm at Stonacek Funeral Home in Norfolk.

Gladys died at home Thursday December 31, 2015 after a courageous battle with cancer. The daughter of Harold and Geralda (Wingert) Klein was born December 3, 1936 on the family farm in Panama, Iowa. She was baptized and confirmed in the Catholic church and attended rural schools before graduating from St Joseph's Catholic High School in Dunlap, Iowa in 1954.

She married Joseph Weis on November 26, 1960 at St Cecilia's Cathedral Church in Omaha. In 1967, the couple moved to Norfolk where Gladys worked at Dale Electronics and JC Penney. Things most precious to Gladys were her faith in God, her family and friends. She loved to, cook, bake, sew quilts, attend all of her grandchildren's activities and spend time visiting with friends. Over the years Gladys volunteered for Meals on Wheels, Adoration Prayer Chain, Rosary Crusade and helping in the church gift shop. She was a member of St Mary's and Sacred Heart Catholic Church and Altar Society.
