



## Glen M. Kolterman

April 30, 1943 - June 10, 2017

The son of Leonard and Emily (Huelle) Kolterman was born April 30, 1943, in Norfolk. He was baptized on May 23, 1943, by the Rev. Sheips and confirmed on April 14, 1957, by the Rev. Harm, both at Zion Lutheran Church at Pierce. He attended Zion Lutheran School in Pierce and graduated from Pierce High School in 1961.

He served in the U.S. Air Guard and attended Iowa State for two years, where he pursued a degree in civil engineering. In 1965, Glen was in a motorcycle accident. He worked in California as a surveyor and then was with the Liberty Centre in Norfolk.

Glen enjoyed reading, talking politics, cards and music. He was a resident at the St. Joseph's Nursing Home for 13 years. The last few years Glen was at The Elms Health Care Center in Ponca.

Survivors include his brother, Jerry (Tomi) Koltermann of Antelope, Calif.; a sister, Marilyn (Jim) Arends of South Sioux City; a niece, Allison; and a nephew, Lawrence.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Leonard and Emily.
