January 23, 1925 - August 11, 2014

OSMOND — Services for Glen A. Kumm, 89, of Norfolk will be at 10:30 a.m. Friday at Immanuel Lutheran Church at Osmond with burial in the parish cemetery and the Rev. Gary Trowbridge and Vicar Glen Emery officiating. Visitation at the church will be 4-8 p.m. Thursday under direction of Stonacek Memorial Chapel of Osmond. He died Monday, Aug. 11, 2014, at Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk. Glen Alvin Kumm was born on a farm three-quarters of a mile north of Osmond on Jan. 23, 1925, to Robert and Meta (Gloe) Kumm. He became a child of God when he was baptized on March 1, 1925, by Rev. Max Braunersreuther at Immanuel Lutheran Church at Osmond. He was confirmed by Eric Holstein on April 10, 1938. He attended eight years at Immanuel Lutheran School and graduated from Osmond High School in 1942. He farmed with his father until he was married to Bernice (Brasch) of Bloomfield by Pastor H.O. Rhode on Jan. 23, 1947. To this union three children were born: Barbara, Gaylord and Myron. They lived six- and one-half-miles west of Wausa where he farmed, sold Triple F feed and sold Chief buildings and bins. They belonged to the Golgotha Lutheran Church at Wausa. From March 1976 to 2001, they built Kumm Inc. in Plainview where he sold Chief buildings and bins. In 2001, they retired to Norfolk and transferred to Immanuel Lutheran Church at Osmond. They spent their winters in Mesa, Ariz. Survivors include his wife, Bernice (Brasch) Kumm, for 67 years; children Barbara (Robert) Petersen of Osmond and Myron (Peg) Kumm of Wausa; 13 grandchildren, Tony (Megan) Kumm of Wausa, Luke

(Katie) Kumm of Wausa, April (Jeff) Alexander of Wausa, Nancy Dunn of Pierce, Nila (Mike) Wanke of Norfolk, Gary (Niki) Petersen of Norfolk, Ivan (Karen) Petersen of Norfolk and Ross (Nora) Petersen of Norfolk, Judy (Buck) deKoning of Summerfield, Kan., Ben (Angela) Kumm of Bloomfield, Glen R. Kumm of Chambers, Starr (Timothy) Graae of Norfolk, DeAnn (Rickie) Naper of South Bend, Ind.; 37 great- and stepgreat-grandchildren; brothers Kenneth (Norma) Kumm of Bloomfield, Milford (Hattie) Kumm of Osmond, Robert (LaVerne) Kumm of Lincoln; and sister Elaine (Lloyd) Timmerman of Osmond and sister-in-law Lavila Kumm of Fremont and numerous nieces and nephews.
