PIERCE — Services for Grace Christensen, 91 Pierce, will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. The Rev. Gordon Bruce will officiate with burial in the Prospect View Cemetery in Pierce. Visitation will be 5-8 p.m. Wednesday at Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce. She died Sunday, May 11, 2014, at Nebraska Heart Hospital in Lincoln. The daughter of Frederick and Ingeborg (Nelson) Albrecht was born Oct. 23, 1922, near Pierce. She was baptized on Jan. 28, 1923, and confirmed on April 18, 1943, at St. John's Lutheran Church at Pierce. She graduated from Pierce High School in 1939, when she was 16 years old. She attended Wayne State College to earn a teaching certificate and taught school until she was married. She married Gale M. Christensen on June 19, 1945, at St. John's Lutheran Church at Pierce by the Rev. Petersen. They farmed after they were married for five years in Wayne County. They were in the machinery, grain hauling and custom farming business. She worked at J.C. Penney's and Maurices in Norfolk. They owned and operated G&G's Gas & Shop in Pierce from 1982 to 1992. Grace loved to play cards at the Senior Center and quilting at Zion Lutheran Church. She regularly attended services at Zion Lutheran Church, where she was a greeter and a member of the ladies aid. She was a lifelong resident of Pierce. Survivors include two sons, Gary and wife Carolyn Christensen of Lincoln and Randall and wife Shelly Christensen of Sturgis, S.D.; four grandchildren; and 12 great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, Frederick and Ingeborg; four brothers, Lawrence, Elmer,

Alfred and Warren Albrecht; one sister, Betty Gansebom; and her husband, Gale, who passed away on Oct. 21, 1999.
