NORFOLK — Memorial services for Greg Thies, 67, Ixtapan de la Sal, Mexico, formerly of Norfolk, will be at 3 p.m. Thursday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. The Rev. Terry Buol will officiate. Burial will be at a later date. He died Sunday, Jan. 3, 2016, at a hospital in Mexico.

The son of Randy and Virginia (Pearson) Thies was born Oct. 30, 1948, in Norfolk. He attended Norfolk High School. After high school, Greg worked at a meat packing plant in Norfolk before moving to West Point around 1970. He worked at IBP for several years until returning to Norfolk in 1989.

Greg owned and operated Fanny Ann's Bar for two years. He moved to Schuyler and worked at Cargill from 1992 to 2011.

On Sept. 2, 1966, he married Linda Peatrowsky. The couple were married for more than 20 years and had two children, Trevis and Shannon, before they divorced.

He met and married his spouse, Elia, in 2011 in Schuyler. They moved to Mexico in 2011, as well.

Greg loved his music, especially country music. He played for country bands throughout the 1970s such as "The Country Classics" and "Midnight Wind."

He passed down his music talents to his children. Trevis and his grandson, Anthony, play drums. Shannon was the lead singer in the band, No Contest.

Greg always enjoyed telling jokes to his family and friends.
