He died Friday, Jan. 1, 2016, at Madison Countryside Home in Madison.

The son of Vernon Clayton and Donnis (Johnson) Omer was born Jan. 7, 1956, at Valentine. He attended kindergarten through second grade at Valentine school and graduated from Ainsworth High School in 1974. He served in the U.S. Marines from July 9, 1974, to July 8, 1976.

He married Tammy Harris on Sept. 22, 1979, at First Methodist Church in Ainsworth. After marriage, they lived at Ainsworth for 10 years. James worked and managed the Tri-County Tire.
