NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Jan A. Grosse, 75, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Saturday, November 4, 2017 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with Rev. Ray S. Wilke officiating. Jan died Monday, October 30, 2017 at her residence in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Born Oct. 9, 1942, in Bloomfield, she was the daughter of Clyde and Ida (Stark) White. She graduated from Bloomfield High School in 1960. Later, she attended Northeast Community College in Norfolk and graduated from nursing school in 1972.

She married Larry Grosse on Sept. 16, 1962, in Plainview. Jan and Larry lived in various places in Nebraska until moving to Norfolk in 1977. Jan worked at Dale Electronics in Norfolk before she received her nursing degree. She then worked at the Norfolk Regional Center from 1972 to 2008. Larry died March 31, 1988.

Jan was a very loving mother and grandmother. She would give her children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren anything they wanted or needed even if she didn't have it. She enjoyed crafts and baking, especially baking her famous cinnamon rolls. She was always caring and ready to help anyone out. She was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Norfolk and the VFW Auxiliary.

Survivors include her children, Scott Grosse of Norfolk and Tammy (Tim) Ferguson of Norfolk; three grandchildren, Kayla (Justin) Shaver, Jennifer (Brian) Lampert and Brock (Katie) Ferguson; and nine great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her spouse, Larry Grosse, and her parents, Clyde and Ida White.
