



Jeanine Dee Wragge

PIERCE – Memorial service for Jeanine D. Wragge, 89 of Pierce, will be held on Wednesday, April 2, 2025 at 10:30AM at Christ Lutheran Church in Pierce. Inurnment will be at Prospect View Cemetery in rural Pierce. Jeanine passed away on March 28, 2025 at Parkside Manor in Stuart, NE. Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce is in charge of the arrangements.

Jeanine Dee (Waterbury) Wragge was born in Norfolk, Nebraska on April 8, 1935 to William and Gladys (Roberts) Waterbury. She passed away on March 28, 2025, in Stuart, Nebraska. Jeanine was a long-time resident of Pierce. In November 2021 Jeanine moved to the Meadows Independent Living in Norfolk, Nebraska. Due to failing health she moved to Parkside Manor in Stuart, Nebraska in January 2022.

Jeanine attended elementary school in Madison County and high school in Norfolk before moving to Pierce and graduating from Pierce High School in 1953. Jeanine was united in marriage to Darrell Wragge on November 16, 1953, in Yankton, South Dakota. On October 1, 1954 she was baptized as an adult and also became a Communicant Member of Christ Lutheran Church in Pierce, Nebraska.

Darrell and Jeanine were blessed with four children, Debra Lee, Terry Darrell, Connie Lynne, and Sharie Marie. Following their marriage Jeanine attended Norfolk Junior College. She also worked at the Montgomery Ward store in Norfolk, Nebraska. Jeanine was later employed by the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services in Pierce. She retired from DHHS in 1997. Jeanine helped at the Pierce Locker doing bookwork for Darrell and Terry, after they purchased the locker in 1979.

Jeanine enjoyed sewing, gardening, caring for her flowers, painting, and doing crafts. She especially enjoyed fishing and camping with Darrell, their family and friends. Many trips in the motorhome, to Branson, Missouri brought much joy and created memories for Jeanine and Darrell.

Jeanine was a member of Christ Evangelical Lutheran Church in Pierce where she was active in Ladies Aid and taught Sunday School. She was also a member of the Pierce Rescue Unit, a 4-H leader, a Cub Scout Leader and delivered meals-on-wheels. She served as a board member of the Pierce Senior Center and was a SHIPP volunteer.

Jeanine is survived by her daughter Debra (Wragge) Kruger of Lincoln, son Terry (Debra Ronspies) Wragge of Pierce, daughter Connie (Larry) Hoefs of Arapahoe, and daughter Sharie (Jack) Flannery of Atkinson. Grandchildren Amy (Kruger) (Rick) Hasenpflug (children: Braydn and Addison), Aric (Karen Heitman) (children: McKenzi (Michael) Maldonado and son Mason; Dean and Natalie).
