BATTLE CREEK – Memorial service for Jeffery C. “Jeff” Wiemers, 58, of Battle Creek will be held at 1:00 p.m., Sunday, July 16, 2023, at the Eckert Event Center in Battle Creek, NE. Private family inurnment will be held at a later date. Jeff passed away on Sunday, July 9, 2023, at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha, NE surrounded by his family. Jeff was born on October 19, 1964, in Rockledge, Florida to Gene and Delores (Besack) Wiemers. He graduated from McCook High School in 1984. Jeff was employed by Rollin Coal as a truck driver. As a driver, Jeff was able to travel the Midwest, but always looked forward to Thursday night poker with friends. He also enjoyed shooting pool with his children and friends. When not traveling, he enjoyed spending time with his family and friends and was a huge Husker and Chiefs fan.
