



## Jerdine E. Luebe

November 17, 1931 - June 4, 2019

PIERCE — Services for Jerdine E. Luebe, 87, Pierce, will be at 10:30 a.m. Monday, June 10, at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. The Rev. Gordon Bruce and Joshua Mork will officiate. Burial will be in Prospect View Cemetery in rural Pierce.

Born Nov. 17, 1931, in Pierce, Jerdine was the daughter of Ernest and Inez (Kettler) Buss. She was baptized on Dec. 1, 1931, and confirmed April 2, 1944, both at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. She attended Pierce County rural school until third grade then went to Zion Parochial school until eighth grade. She graduated from Pierce High School in May 1948 and then from Wayne State Teachers College in 1975.

She and Delmar “Shadow” Luebe were married by the Rev. E.J. Bernthal on June 8, 1953, at Grace Lutheran Church in Wayne. They lived in Pierce.

Jerdine taught for 42 years in various rural schools in Pierce and Wayne counties and in Woodland Park. She retired from teaching in 2003 at Woodland Park in rural Norfolk. Delmar passed away on Aug. 29, 2010.

Jerdine enjoyed playing with her grandchildren and great-grandchildren, cooking and baking and playing cards. Jerdine loved spending time with her family. She was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce, Zion Ladies Aid and Pierce Legion Auxiliary.

Survivors include a son, Doug (Christina) Luebe of Ponca; two daughters, Margo (Kevin) Brown of Lincoln and Roxanne (Gary) Hilkemann of Pierce; 14 grandchildren; 13 great-grandchildren; a sister, Karen (Don) Hogendorn of Norfolk; and many nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Ernest and Inez; her spouse, Delmar; her brothers, Chester and Randy; and a sister, Nina Jones.
