



## Jerome C. Woockman

Woockman was born on Oct. 4, 1935, in Norfolk, to Clarence and Elvera (Sydow) Woockman. He was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church in Hoskins. He attended District 85 in Wayne County through grade school and finished junior high school at Trinity Lutheran School in Hoskins before graduating high school from Hoskins in 1953. He was a member of Christ Lutheran Church and Servants of the Savior group at Christ Lutheran Church, Norfolk.
