



## Joan "Joanne" Anderson

March 8, 1925 - May 7, 2016

NORFOLK — Services for Joan “Joanne” Anderson, 91, Norfolk, will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Norfolk. The Rev. Matthew Niggemeyer will officiate with burial in Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery. Visitation will be 4-7 p.m. Wednesday at the Stonacek Funeral chapel in Norfolk with a 7 p.m. rosary. She died Saturday, May 7, 2016, at Madison Countryside Home in Madison.

The daughter of Henry and Julia (Dittrich) Voigt was born March 8, 1925, at Tilden. She attended rural school at Tilden to eighth grade and graduated from Tilden High School in 1941. After high school graduation Joanne moved to Omaha and worked at the Martin Bomber Plant.

She married Rueben Anderson on Feb. 12, 1947, at the Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Norfolk. The couple lived west of Pierce, where they farmed. In 1951, they moved south of Norfolk, where they continued to farm. She worked at the Norfolk Hatchery and Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk. In 2004, Joanne moved to the Madison House of Norfolk and then to St. Joseph’s Assisted Living of Norfolk. She had been at the Madison Country Side Home since January 2014. She enjoyed spending time with her family and friends, cooking and sewing.

She was a member of St. Mary’s Catholic Altar Society and the VFW Auxiliary. Survivors include three sons, Robert and spouse Pam Anderson of Norfolk, Jerry and spouse Barbara Anderson of Norfolk, and Charles Anderson of Norfolk; a daughter-in-law, Judy (Anderson) Eacker of Norfolk; a brother, Dale

and spouse Peg Voigt of Norfolk; a sister, Rita Cox of Norfolk; 14 grandchildren; 16 great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews.
