OSMOND — Services for Joan M. Brummond Gansebom, 78, of Osmond will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond. The Rev. Gary Trowbridge and Vicar Glen Emery of Osmond will officiate with burial in the Osmond Lutheran Cemetery. Visitation at the church will be 4-8 p.m. Wednesday. Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Osmond is in charge of the arrangements. She died Saturday, June 7, 2014, at Osmond General Hospital. Joan M. (Brummond) Gansebom was born to Ed and Frieda (Schuettler) Brummond on May 12, 1936, on the farm near McLean. Joan was baptized on May 31, 1936, and confirmed April 2, 1950, by Rev. Wieting. She attended rural grade school, Immanuel Lutheran School and graduated from Osmond High School in 1954. Joan graduated from Wayne State College in 1979 with a B.S. in education degree and from Concordia University in Seward with a Lutheran teacher's degree in 1985. Joan married Delmer Gansebom on Feb. 10, 1957. To this union four children were born: Tim, Lori, Tom and Lisa. After 43 years of teaching, Joan will be remembered by many as an outstanding, caring teacher. She was active in the Immanuel Lutheran Ladies Aid, the American Legion Auxiliary and the 8/40 Madison Salon. Joan taught Sunday school and confirmation classes at Immanuel. She was a 4-H leader for 40 years and was awarded the Pierce County Hall of Fame Award in 2002 and the Outstanding Volunteer Nebraska Association of County Extension Boards in 1993. She also received an award for 57 years of continuous membership in the American Legion Auxiliary Unit 326. Survivors
