He had one of the first center pivots in Pierce County in 1970. He sat and passed his chemigation test at age 84. He was one of the first to start minimum tillage. He still did all the planting in the spring and drove the combine in the fall during harvest. He enjoyed and loved his family and farming. He was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church, Pierce. Survivors include two daughters, Connie and husband Jon Brandt of Pierce, Elaine and husband Dennis Renner of Norfolk; one son, Douglas Vyhldal of Norfolk; eight grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; one brother, Arthur and wife Judy Vyhldal of Randolph; two sisters, Sophie Eldhart of Pierce, Pat and husband Louis Herbolsheimer of Hartington; one sister-in-law, Donna Vyhldal of North Platte.
