NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Katharina Sauer, 88, of Norfolk will be held at 10:00 a.m., Friday, June 14, 2019 at the St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Pierce with Father Marc Lim officiating. Interment will be held at the Resurrection Cemetery in San Gabriel, California. Visitation will be 5:00-7:00 p.m., Thursday, at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk with a 7:00 p.m. vigil service. Katharina died Tuesday, June 11, 2019 at the Homestead Assisted Living in Norfolk. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements. Born Feb. 11, 1931, in Murga Kreis Tolna, Hungary, she was the daughter of Martin and Katharina Hohmann. She was baptized and confirmed in the Catholic faith and attended a Catholic grade school in Hungary to the eighth grade.

On April 29, 1950, she married Anton Sauer Sr. Katharina and Anton lived in Ulm, Germany. They moved to the United States in 1955 to California, where Katharina worked in the electronics industry for almost 20 years. They later moved to Nebraska in 1974. Katharina also worked another 20 years in the electronics industry at Dale Electronics.

She was a member of St. Joseph's Catholic Church in Pierce.

She was preceded in death by her spouse, Anton Sauer Sr.; a son, Anton Sauer Jr.; her parents; and a brother, Lukas Hohmann. They all have gone home.
