PIERCE -- Services for Kenneth Louis Hoeppe, 74, Pierce, will be Tuesday at 10:30 a.m. at Christ Lutheran Church here in Pierce with the Rev. Casey Lienemann officiating. Military rites will be by Tomek-Otto Post 72 American Legion, Pierce, and U.S. Army Honors Guard. Burial will be in Prospect View Cemetery, Pierce. Visitation will be 4 to 8 p.m. on Monday at Stonacek Memorial Chapel, Pierce. He died on Thursday, Jan. 31, 2013, at Faith Regional Health Services in Norfolk. He was born March 21, 1938, at Osmond, the son of Louis and Mary (Reimer) Hoeppe. He attended Osmond Public Schools and graduated from Osmond High School in 1955. He served in the U.S. Army from June 21, 1955, to June 20, 1958, during the Korean War. He married Marilyn Ordway at Christ Lutheran Church in Pierce on Feb. 6, 1966. He was a truck driver and member of Christ Lutheran Church in Pierce. After serving in the U.S. Army, the couple lived in Osmond for two years. Kenneth worked for Theisen Brothers Construction until 1967. The couple then moved to Norfolk in 1968, where Kenneth then worked for Affiliated Foods for 37 years. He retired in 2004. They moved up to Pierce in 2007. The couple attended craft shows through the years. Kenneth was an avid card player and also enjoyed playing pool at the Pierce Senior Center. On Thursday mornings, he attended the Affiliated coffee group gatherings at Hy-Vee. He bought a three-wheel scooter that he enjoyed driving around with his son, John. Survivors include one son, John and wife, Lisa Hoeppe of Pierce; and granddaughter, Hailey of Pierce; one brother, Rod Hoeppe of

Bellwood; two sisters, Shirley Greiner of Seward and Hilda Wecker of Lincoln. He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife, Marilyn on Jan. 9, 2008; five sisters and three brothers, two in infancy. Organist for the service will be Mrs. Lisa Gerdes.
