



## Kenneth F. "Kenny" Wieting

June 27, 1940 - July 26, 2025

PIERCE – Funeral service for Kenneth F. “Kenny” Wieting, 85, of Pierce, will be held at 10:30 a.m. Friday, August 1, 2025 at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk, Nebraska. Officiating the service will be P.M.A. Jacquie Samway. A visitation will be held from 5:00 – 7:00 p.m. Thursday, July 31, 2025 at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Interment will take place at the Zion Lutheran Cemetery rural Pierce following the funeral luncheon. Military rites will be conducted by the American Legion Tomek Otto Post #72 and the United States Army Honor Guard. Kenny passed away on Saturday, July 26, 2025 at his residence in rural Pierce with his family by his side. Stonacek Funeral Chapel is in charge of the arrangements.

Kenny was born on June 27, 1940 in Pierce, Nebraska to Fred and Alta (Zierke) Wieting. He grew up and lived in Pierce his whole life, attending country school until the 8th grade before attending Pierce High School. He enlisted into the United States Army on April 18, 1962 and during his time in the military he earned his G.E.D. Kenny was honorably discharged on April 17, 1964. He married Sandra Evans in April of 1963 in Yankton, SD. To this union were two kids, Lucinda and Perry, the couple later divorced. He married Diana Jelinek on December 16, 1999 in Center, Nebraska. Kenny worked for Blyle Construction then later became self-employed farming and well drilling. Kenny was a member of the American Legion Tomek-Otto Post #72 and Christ Lutheran Church both of Pierce. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, playing

cards, chasing cows and going for drives checking and critiquing people's cattle and crops.

He is survived by his wife Diana Wieting of Pierce, children Lucinda Llewellyn of Plainview, Perry (Jill) Wieting of Pierce; along with five grandchildren, several great-grandchildren, one great-great grandson and sister Mary Sporleder of Pierce.

He is preceded in death by his parents Fred and Alta Wieting, brother-in-law Roland Sporleder, and his uncle Carl Ingram.
