



Larry W. Glandt

NORFOLK -- Funeral service for Larry W. Glandt, 71, of Norfolk will be held at 10:30 a.m., Thursday, October 5, 2017 at the First Christian Church in Norfolk with Tim DeFor and Randall Coffin officiating. Interment will be at Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery, Norfolk. Visitation will be 5:00-7:00 p.m., Wednesday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. Larry died Sunday, October 1, 2017 at his residence in Norfolk.

Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk is in charge of the arrangements.

Born Oct. 27, 1945, in Norfolk, he was the son of Darold and Myrtis (Hoffman) Glandt. He attended grade school in rural Tilden at School District 4 until the sixth grade and graduated from Tilden High School in 1964. After high school, Larry worked in construction, and then worked at Henningsen Foods in Norfolk. Larry later worked at Culligan in Norfolk and then at the 3M factory. He married Sherrill Reed on Dec. 19, 1965, at Church Of Christ in Cherokee, Iowa. On Dec. 4, 1978, Larry began working at Nucor. He worked there until he retired Feb. 1, 2008, after 30 years.

Larry enjoyed his church life, fishing, hunting, golfing and serving others. Larry was always caring, loving and giving to his family and spouse, Sherrill. He also enjoyed spending his last hours hand-picking potatoes and delivering them to others.

He was a member of First Christian Church of Norfolk. He held numerous positions at the church. He was a yoke fellow, elder, deacon and a handyman at the church.

Survivors are his spouse, Sherrill Glandt of Norfolk; children Teena (Rod) Andersen of Pilger and Darren (Lisa) Glandt of Omaha; three grandchildren, Hayley (Will) Royle of Central City, Alyssa Andersen and fiancé Jordan Breitreutz of Wisner and Marcia Glandt of Omaha; one great-granddaughter, Miley Breitreutz of Wisner; and his siblings, twin sister Lavonne (Ray) Danenhauer of Cedar Rapids, Iowa, Roger Glandt of Las Vegas, Lucille (Jerry) Smith of Norfolk, Va., and Susan Reed of Norfolk.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Darold and Myrtis; a brother, Ron Glandt; and his sisters-in-law, Barbara Glandt and JoAnn Glandt.
