Visitation will be held 4:00-7:00 p.m., Friday at the Stonacek Funeral Chapel in Norfolk. She passed away on Saturday, May 20, 2017, at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha. The daughter of Marlyn and Laurita (Lambert) Nitz was born May 1, 1972, in Norfolk. 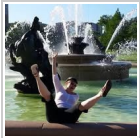
