LaVern enjoyed gardening, crocheting, knitting and reading.

She was a member of the Fairview United Methodist Church in Madison.

Survivors include her children, Michal R. Glaser of Austin, Texas, Kurt R.

(Denise) Glaser of Redmond, Wash., Tammie K. (Tracy) Sizemore of Parker, Colo., and Nancy J. (Ted) Woods of St. Louis, Mo., nine grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her spouse, Lester; her parents; her siblings, Alberta Wemmie, Everett Schulz, Arnold Schulz, Pearl Boe, Wilbur Schulz, Kenneth Schulz and Harlan Schulz.
