She was confirmed on March 21, 1948, at Zion Lutheran Church in Plainview. She attended School District 40 in Pierce County and graduated from Plainview High School in 1952. After high school, LaVonne taught at a country school near Breslau from 1952 to 1953.

She married Phillip Lubke on April 26, 1953, at Zion Lutheran Church in Plainview. LaVonne and Phillip lived and farmed near Foster for 33 years. She worked at Wal-Mart in Norfolk for 12 years before retiring in the late 1980s.

LaVonne and Phillip moved to Hadar in 1986.

Lavonne was very active in the Trinity Lutheran Church in Foster throughout her life. LaVonne enjoyed crafts, sewing, canning, gardening, raising chickens

and cooking and baking for her family. She especially enjoyed making fried chicken and kuchen bread.
