NORFOLK — LeRoy M. "Shorty" Schuett, 84, of Norfolk died Sunday, Aug. 19, 2012, at the Norfolk Veterans Home.

Services will be at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Stonacek Funeral Chapel, Norfolk, with burial in Immanuel Lutheran Cemetery, Hadar, and visitation 5 to 8 p.m. Wednesday. The Rev. Norman Nelson will officiate. Military rites will be by American Legion Post 16, VFW Post 1644 and the United States Army Honors Guard.

He was born March 1, 1928, at Bloomfield to Detlef and Dorothea (Hansen) Schuett and was baptized at St. Mark's Evangelical Lutheran Church, Bloomfield. He attended Bloomfield Public Schools to ninth grade.

He was married to Rose Lederer Jan. 23, 1965, at United Methodist Church, Osmond. They lived in Norfolk and then moved to Hadar.

Shorty worked at Petring Motors and later Vern Dahl Ford. He then worked at the Norfolk Regional Center as boiler room operator. They divorced in 1982. He retired in 1992, helping Gary and Cathy at their shop Hometown Auto Repair, picking up parts at local parts stores and running errands. He enjoyed

spending time with family and scrapping iron throughout the years.

He served in the Army during the Korean War from Aug. 28, 1952, to Aug. 10, 1954. He was a life member of VFW.

Survivors include son Gary and wife Cathy Schuett of Hadar; two granddaughters, Synthia and Krystina Schuett of Hadar; sister Elaine Hanzlik of Norfolk.

He was preceded in death by parents; six brothers, Emil, Alvin, Don, Herb, Ed, Dale; three sisters, Helen Weaver, Dorthy Bayly, one sister in infancy, Ethel.
