She began working as a dental technician in 1965 for Wells Dental Lab until 1980. She then worked at the City Attorney's office for two years. She enjoyed her flowers, little vegetable gardens, and watching baseball and Husker football games. She was a member of Christ Lutheran

Church, Norfolk, she volunteered with church activities, and enjoyed china painting with her friends and carving birds out of wood.

Survivors include her sons Curtis (Janet) Nielsen of Tyndall, S.D., Mitch (Karen) Nielsen of Madison, 4 grandchildren Diane (Mike) Tworek, Dani (Brian) Hadcock, Shawn (Amanda) Nielsen, Nicholas (Robin) Nielsen, 8 great-grandchildren, sister Janet (Gene) Claussen of Wayne.
