OSMOND — Services for Lorene M. Fleming, 96, of Osmond will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday at the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond. The Rev. Gary Trowbridge and Vicar Glen Emery will officiate with burial in Hillcrest Memorial Park Cemetery in Norfolk. Visitation will be 5-7 p.m. Monday at the Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Osmond. She died Thursday, Sept. 25, 2014, at the Osmond General Hospital in Osmond. She was born March 5, 1918, in Pierce County, the daughter of Robert and Clara (Kuether) Koehler. She was baptized and confirmed at the St. John's Lutheran Church in Pierce. She attended Pierce County rural schools and then St. John's Parochial School. On Sept. 20, 1939, she and Richard Fleming were married at St. John's Lutheran Church in Pierce. Lorene and Richard lived on farms in the Osmond area following their marriage. After retiring from the farm where she had lived for 41 years, the couple moved to Osmond in 1959, where she worked at Chick's Grocery Store for five years. She also worked at the Osmond General Hospital as a central supply technician for 18 years, from 1967 to 1986. She then did housecleaning for 3½ years and helped the elderly until her retirement. Lorene enjoyed sewing, gardening, visiting, and reminiscing with family and friends. Mrs. Fleming was an active member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Osmond and was a member of its ladies aid. Survivors include son Dennis Fleming of Norfolk; daughter Marlene Fleming of Parker, Colo.; five grandchildren; 11 great grandchildren; sisters-in-law Alta Koehler of Adel, Iowa, and Mabel Grayson of Lewiston, Idaho; and numerous nieces,

nephews and cousins. She was preceded in death by husband Richard in 1990; parents Robert and Clara; two sisters, Edna and Bill Korth and Leila Mae Koehler; two brothers, Arthur Koehler and Gilbert Koehler and wife Esther; and son Robert Fleming.
