Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce is in charge of the arrangements. Lotcher "Al" Wainscott was born on October 16, 1931 in Columbia, MO, to Lotcher Flecher and Malvina Helen (LeMert) Wainscott. Al's father worked in soil conservation that caused the family to move many times before settling in Belvidere, IL. Al graduated from the University of Illinois in 1954 with a degree in Civil Engineering. Al served his country as a Captain in the Air Force from July 1955 to June 1957. After moving to California, Al met Janice A. Brooks on a blind date. They were married five months later on September 3, 1960. After working for several engineering firms they moved to Riverside, CA and raised three children there; Craig, Brian, and Laura. In 1977, Al opened his own engineering firm; L.A. Wainscott & Associates, Inc. Al and Jan were members of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Riverside. Al enjoyed model building, Kiwanis Club, and time with his family. In 2016, they sold their house of 53 years and moved to Pierce to be near their daughter Laura Ahlers and family. Survivors include his wife Jan Wainscott of Pierce, children Craig (Aya) Wainscott of Seattle, WA, Brian (Jan) Wainscott of Seabeck, WA, Laura (John) Ahlers of Pierce, nine grandchildren, seven great-grandchildren, and sister Jane Skogman of
