PIERCE -- Funeral service for Louis Eldon Schulz, 76, of Osmond will be held at 10:30 a.m., Wednesday, April 12, 2017 at the St. John's Lutheran Church, rural Pierce with Rev. Lucas Miller officiating. Interment will be in the Parish cemetery, rural Pierce. Visitation will be held 4-8:00 p.m., Tuesday also at St. John's Lutheran Church, Pierce. Military rites will be conducted by the American Legion Tomek-Otto Post 72 of Pierce and the United States Army Honors Guard. Eldon passed away Saturday, April 8, 2017 at the Norfolk Veterans Home. Stonacek Memorial Chapel in Pierce is in charge of the arrangements.

Louis Eldon Schulz, the son of Reinhold and Luella (Buckendahl) Schulz, was born June 17, 1940, in Norfolk. Eldon was baptized on June 17, 1940, in Norfolk and confirmed April 11, 1954, at St. John's Lutheran Church in rural Pierce. He attended St. John's parochial school through the eighth grade and graduated from Pierce High School in 1958.

Eldon served in the U.S. Army from May 23, 1962, to May 22, 1964.

He married Karen Schomberg on Feb. 25, 1968, at Zion Lutheran Church in Pierce. The couple lived in the Piece area. Eldon worked for Walt Fleer farms. He started at Nucor Steel in Norfolk in November 1975 and worked there until April 2003, when he retired. Eldon was a crane operator and supervisor while at Nucor Steel.

Eldon enjoyed dancing, playing cards, mowing the yard, giving his grandkids rides on his gator and watching John Wayne movies. He has been a resident

at Norfolk Veterans Home since June of 2013.

He was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church of rural Pierce, held numerous church offices over the years, taught Sunday school and sang in St. John's Church choir.

Survivors are his spouse, Karen Schulz of Osmond; his children, Perry (Diane) Schulz of Pierce, Jeff Schulz and friend Shanna Waterman of Pierce, Kris (Todd) Sittig of Poplar Bluff, Mo., Cory (Kerry) Schulz of Madison, Kan., Wendi Schulz of Lincoln and Debi (Scott) Doerr of Creighton; eight grandchildren; his siblings, Ione Fahrenholz of Scribner, Leon (Connie) Schulz of Hadar; and many nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Reinhold and Luella; two brothers, Delbert and Marvin; and a sister, Iralane Carstens.

Organist for the service will be Jean Zautke, and soloist will be Jill McElhose. Musical selections will be "How Great Thou Art," "In The Garden" and congregational hymn "What A Friend We Have In Jesus."
